

Analiza bazy PsycARTICLES pod kątem tytułów przypisanych do słowa kluczowego „bibliotherapy”

Analysis of the PsycARTICLES database – titles assigned to the keyword „bibliotherapy”

Abstrakt

Przedmiotem artykułu będzie analiza bazy PsycARTICLES pod kątem tytułów przypisanych do słowa kluczowego „bibliotherapy”. Przedstawiona zostanie również bibliografia biblioterapeutyczna bazy PsycARTICLES.

Abstract

The article will examine PsycARTICLES database titles assigned to the keyword „bibliotherapy”. There will be presented the bibliography of bibliotherapeutic literature available in PsycARTICLES database.

PsycARTICLES baza danych opracowana przez American Psychological Association (APA), to wiarygodne źródło pełnotekstowych recenzowanych artykułów naukowych z dziedziny psychologii. Baza zawiera przeszło 153 000 artykułów z ponad 80 czasopism wydawanych przez stowarzyszenie American Psychological Association (APA) i fundację Educational Publishing Foundation (EPF), a także zaprzyjaźnione organizacje, takie jak Canadian Psychology Association oraz Hogrefe Publishing Group. Zakres chronologiczny materiałów sięga roku 1894, a zbiór obejmuje niemal wszystkie czasopisma APA od volumenu 1, wydanie 1. (<http://web.a.ebscohost.com/>). Zgodnie z tezaurusem PsycINFO do bazy PsycARTICLES termin bibliotherapy pierwszy raz został użyty w 1973 r. Biblioterapia definiowana jest jako użycie czytania jako wsparcia dla psychoterapii (use of reading as adjunct to psychotherapy), w szerszym znaczeniu jako leczenie (treatment) a za znaczenie powiązane z biblioterapią (related terms) uznano poezjoterapię (poetry therapy).

Do wartości logicznej/frazy BIBLIOTHERAPY w bazie PsycARTICLES przypisano 70 wyników wyszukiwania tzn. 70 pełnotekstowych artykułów opublikowanych

w czasopismach naukowych (recenzowanych naukowych) w przedziale czasowym 1948-2015.

Wyszukane artykuły ukazały się w następujących wydawnictwach: american psychological association (49), american association for applied psychology (25), dentan printing company (25), science press printing company (25), educational publishing foundation (20), division of psychotherapy (29), american psychological association (10).

Zaprezentowana analiza miała na celu uświadomić autonomiczność biblioterapii jako nauki w obszarze nauk społecznych. Obecność artykułów związanych z biblioter-

pię w jednej z najważniejszych, elektronicznych pełnotekstowych baz danych z dziedziny psychologii podnosi rangę terapii czytelniczej jak i rzutuje na jej rozpoznawalność. Teksty związane z biblioterapią a opublikowane w prestiżowych psychologicznych czasopismach naukowych dotyczą wielu obszarów i tematów, grup wiekowych, przedstawiają różne podejścia metodologiczne – a tym samym doskonale sygnalizują interdyscyplinarność biblioterapii.
