Niniejsza praca stawia sobie za cel przedstawienie liczby publikacji, ich rodzaju oraz reprezentowanego obszaru – wyszukiwanych za pomocą słowu kluczowego *bibliotherapy* w przedziale czasowym 1941-2017 w bazie *SAGE Journals Online*.

Pełnotekstowa wielodziedzinowa baza danych *SAGE Journals Online* gromadzi pełne teksty artykułów z czasopism naukowych z zakresu **nauk ekonomicznych, społecznych i humanistycznych**, wydawanych w głównej mierze przez wydawnictwo SAGE Publications. Zgodnie z Journal Citation Reports z 2016 r. koncern SAGE jest piątym największym wydawcą czasopism naukowych na świecie (ponad 1000 tytułów z zakresu humanistyki, nauk społecznych, przyrodniczych, technologii i medycyny)².

Do wartości logicznej/frazy BIBLIOTHERAPY w bazie *SAGE Journals Online* przypisano 626 wyników wyszukiwania w tym przede wszystkim publikacji z dostępem do pełnego tekstu w przedziale czasowym 1941-2017 r.³
